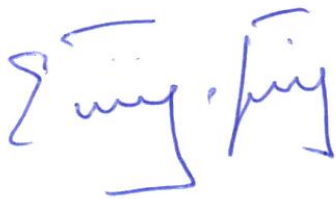

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I. POLICY FOUNDATIONS

1. Preamble

The Elon Musk University of East Africa (EMUEA) Admissions Policy establishes the framework for the **fair, transparent, and merit-based selection of students** into the University's academic programmes.

As a digital and placement-based institution built on **Placement-Based Education for Impact (PBEI)**, EMUEA adopts an admissions approach that goes beyond traditional academic entry criteria to consider:

- Readiness for **real-world, practice-based learning**
- Ability to engage in **self-directed and impact-oriented education**

4. Definitions of Key Terms

- **Applicant:**
An individual applying for admission to an EMUEA programme

- **Placement Requirement:**
A condition where students must have access to an approved placement environment
- **Programme Entry Requirements:**
Academic and other criteria required for admission
- **Conditional Admission:**
Admission granted subject to meeting specified requirements

5. Core Principles of Admissions
