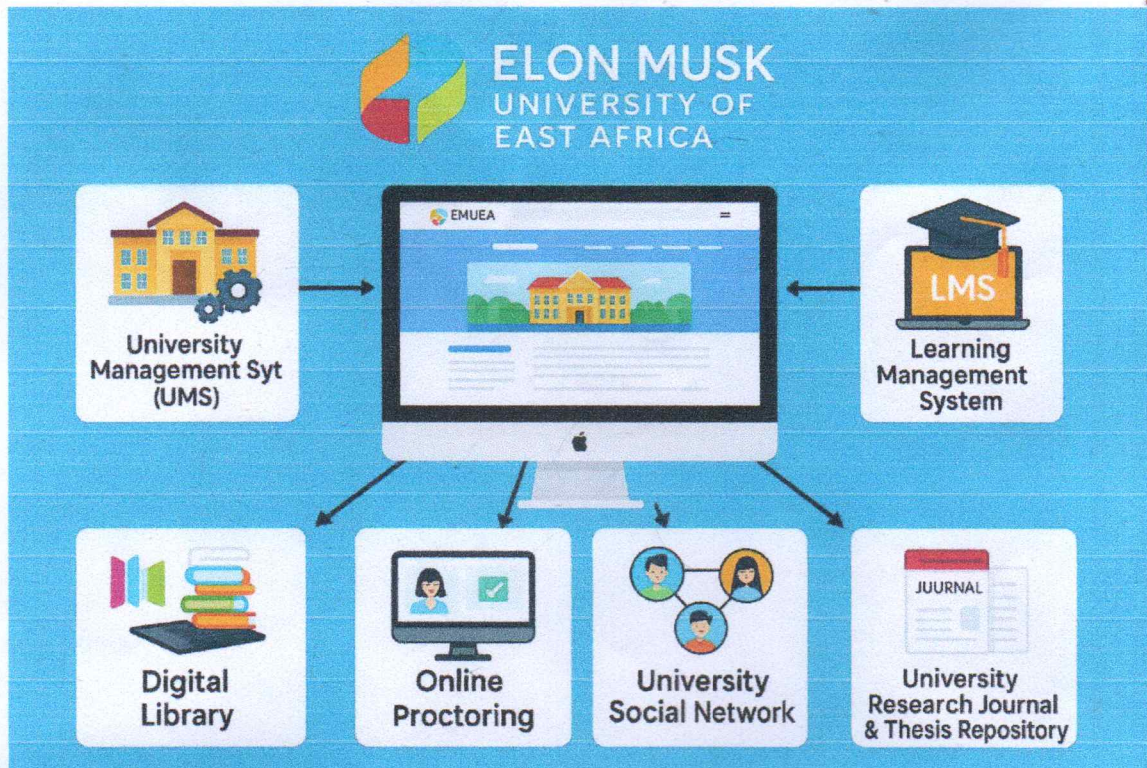
✚ Placement-Based Education for Impact (PBEI)
